While borrowing and returning book ...

- Two books to PG students and one book to UG Students (per week) will be issued against their I-Card
- Check the book at the time of issuing. Incase of any defect or damage please inform the library staff.
- Return the issued book on or before the due date
- Renewal is compulsory before the due date
- •otherwise fine will be charged at Rs. 1/- per text book and Rs.5/- for reference book per day.
- Book marked REFERENCE" /Journals, magazines/ thesis & project ports/maps will not be issued outside the library
- In case of lost or damage of book, replacement of book has to be made by the user.
