Library collection:

Total number of printed books in the central library has reached up to 31080 of Rs 1 crore along with millions of e-books and 4500 audio books. In the year 2018-19 library has received 2342 books as donation. Library has subscribed 96 periodical in the library which contains nationals, international journals and magazines. Library has taken membership of N List Infibnet Consotia to access online paid and free e-journal, e-book and other scholarly publications in electronic forms. Library has subscribed J-Gate Basic Science databases which give access to more than 10 thousand e-journals with their archives and more than 2 crores.

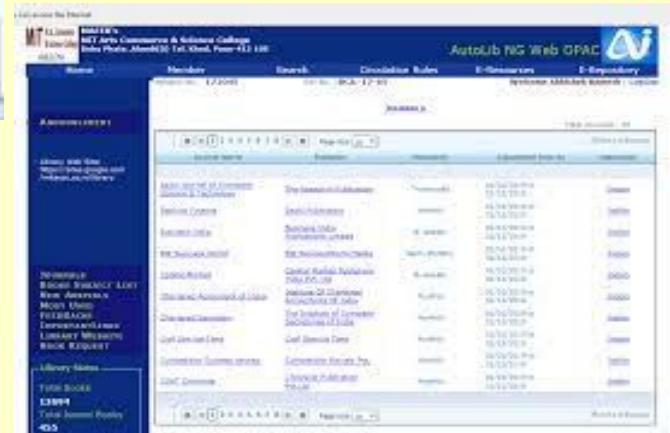

Services include reference, lending e resources into retrieval, browsing, photocopying, books on demand, book exhibition, new arrival counter, readers' awareness etc. Every Constituent unit has ensured the best library resources which follows open access system.

This helps librarian for the issue and return of books, with a large and impressive library counter. General books can be issued by students and faculty. Reference books, bound volumes and standards are issued only to following members: Faculty and Equivalent Staff Members. A book can have maximum two renewals.

Library is fully automated with AUTOLIB software and KOHA web opac is available on the library website. For content library management is using DSpace software. Using this software library has created institutional repository and giving access to e-books, learning material prepared by teachers, faculty publications, syllabus, pervious year question papers, project reports, CD-DVDs and audio books.

- R K Narayan

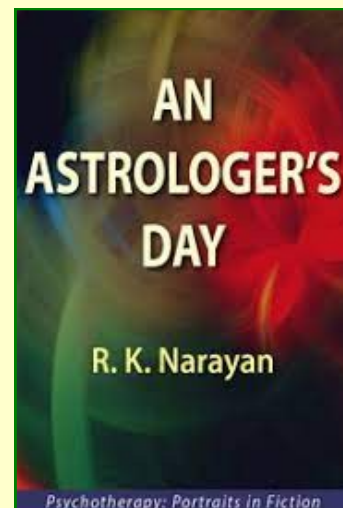
