She started her lecture by giving introduction to Behavioural Ecology which is the study of animal behavior under different ecological conditions. She stressed on the importance of animals in the wild and their typical stereotyped patterns. She also emphasised on the importance of framing study designs and asking questions in those regards so that many facts about the animal can be stressed upon and studied. Several questions as what are the proximate

causes, ontogeny, survival value, and phylogeny of an animal are very crucial to draw any conclusion about their behaviour.

Undergraduate students participated in this activity. During the activity, UG students visited various school in rural and urban areas of Pune. UG students provide experiential learning experience to school students and explained various topics related to Conserve Mother earth such as Endangered species, deforestation and Wild life depletion and conservation, pollution and its control, global climate change and its solutions, recent disease outbreaks and their prevention etc. They also demonstrated the students about blood group testing, hemoglobin estimation and blood transfusion. They also performed experiments related to preparation of thin blood film and total blood count. They also addressed the school students about the scope, job opportunities in the field of basics traditional sciences such as Taxonomy, Systematics, Entomology, and its amalgamation with applied sciences such as Genetics, Molecular Biology, Pharmacogenomics, and Agriculture.
