#### **Departmental Activities:**

# ❖ 1 August 2015: Lokmanya Tilak 95<sup>th</sup> Death Anniversary

The Wagheshwar temple at Wagholi is an ancient temple and a worship place during Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. The students were guided about the historical importance as well as the architectural details of the temple.

Aga Khan Palace, the important monument of the Gandhian era was visited. There is a museum and the Samadhi of Kasturba Gandhi. The pictures and articles associated with the Gandhian era of Indian National movement are displayed in the museum.
